Quality time –Get to Know each other, set aside 1 on 1 time. Disconnect from the outside world and focus on each other.	 We learn more about God's character through studying his word. Hebrews 13:8 "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever." – God is constant and consistent. 1 John 1:5 "5 This is the message we have heard from him and declare to you: God is light; in him there is no darkness at all". 1 on 1 time with God is pivotal in enhancing your relationship. Set aside time for daily devotion.
Compliment themMake them feel good about themselves, notice them, recognise their qualities.	 Praise and worship, glorify God in all of your actions Psalm 69:30 "I will praise the name of God with song and magnify Him with thanksgiving."

Don't do too much, and/or too little –Don't be desperate, have boundaries, don't suffocate them. Exercise balance and moderation. Give God the praise and respect he deserves.
Find out their love language- Words of affirmation, acts of service, receiving gifts, quality time or physical touch.	 Behave in the way the bible says pleases God. 1 John 2:17 "The world and everything in it that people desire is passing away; but those who do the will of God live forever."
Show you care-Make them feel special, Listen to their problems or concerns. Do so something to show you care, don't just say that you do.	 Acknowledge Him. Put God first, even if you have to make sacrifices to do this. Psalm37.4 "Take delight in the Lord, and he will give you the desires of your heart." Show gratitude and thank God for his many blessings.
Make sure you look presentable	 Glorify God in the way that you dress Colossians 3:17 "And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him". 1 Corinthians 6:19 "Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own".
