Health and Safety | We are currently in the process of repairing the foot path at the rear of church repaired. We are kindly ask that extra care is taken whilst walking in this area

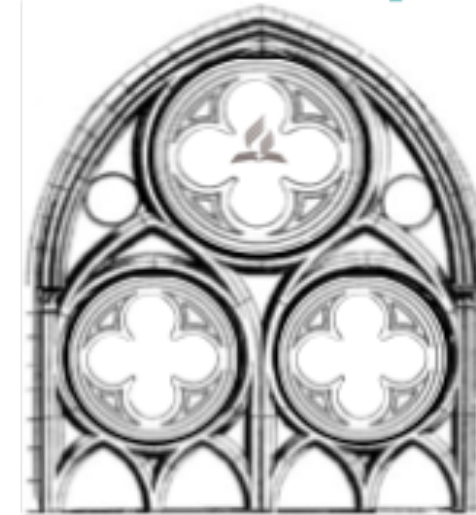
