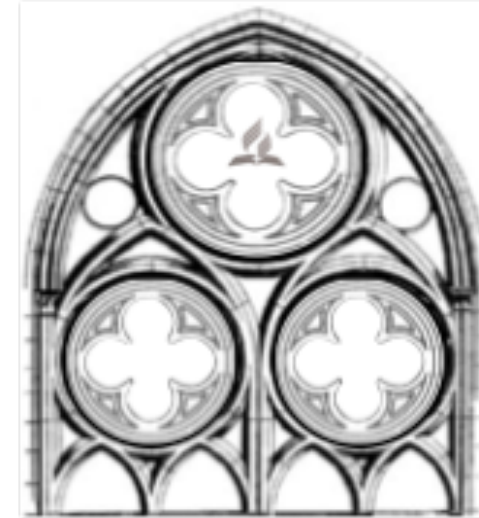
Health and Safety: We are currently in the process of repairing the footpath at the rear of the church. We are kindly asking that extra care is taken whilst walking in this area.
