Tithes & Offering: For tithes and offerings returned by cheque, please make it payable to: South England Conference or S.E.C.

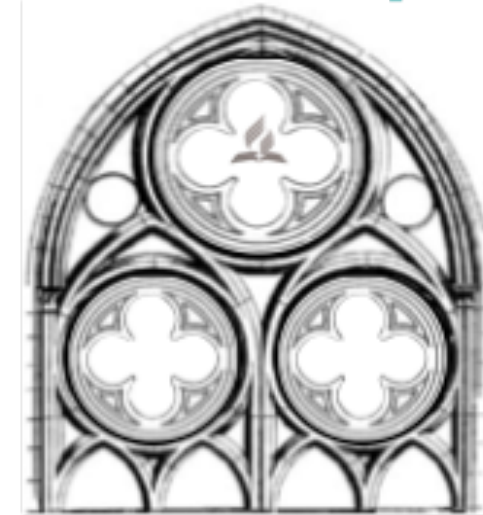
Health and Safety: We are currently in the process of repairing the footpath at the rear of the church. We are kindly asking that extra care is taken whilst walking in this area.
