Tithes & Offering: For tithes and offerings returned by cheque, please make it payable to: South England Conference or S.E.C.

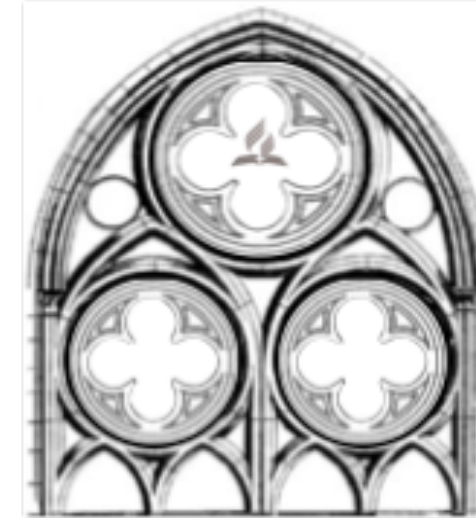
Health and Safety: The remedial works to the back footpath are complete and it is now safe to use.
